Alternoil customers now able to make cashless payments at LIQVIS LNG filling stations

LNG truck drivers can now fill up their vehicles at LNG filling stations operated by LIQVIS and make cashless payments with the Alternoil fuel card. Alternoil is an active participant in the expansion of a comprehensive network of LNG and bio-LNG filling stations in Europe. As a part of this process the medium-sized company is capitalising on the existing partner network by accepting a wide range of filling cards, as well as on the company's existing filling station infrastructure. Alternoil is pursuing a holistic concept, which includes the planning, construction, smooth operation and supply of filling stations for advanced fuels.

This year, we are expanding our network to include approximately 30 sites. The partnership with LIQVIS is another important step in expanding the LNG infrastructure and advancing the common goal of sustainable heavy-duty transportation."

LNG trucks release very little particulate matter and nitrogen oxide, which means they easily meet the high environmental requirements of the Euro VI emission standards. Moreover, heavy-duty trucks weighing over 18 tonnes with an annual mileage of at least 100,000 kilometres have significantly lower fuel costs than diesel vehicles. A further advantage of vehicles powered by LNG is that they are exempt from motorway tolls in Germany.

Uniper subsidiary LIQVIS has been operating LNG filling stations since 2017. These are located at strategic transport hubs that serve a particularly high volume of trucks, such as Berlin-Grünheide, Hannover-Langenhagen and Kassel-Lohfelden. To meet the increasing demand for this alternative fuel, systematic expansion of the German LNG filling station infrastructure is planned for the coming years. As such, this year LIQVIS stations will also be commissioned in the Bad Honnef, Bönen and Magdeburg regions, for example.
